Harrisburg, PA – Today, Governor Josh Shapiro signed Senate Bill 37(opens in a new tab) – known as Paul Miller's Law – into law, prohibiting the use of hand-held devices while driving. This bipartisan legislation makes Pennsylvania the 29<sup>th</sup> state in the nation to ban distracted driving.

Paul Miller's Law allows law enforcement to issue a ticket when a driver uses a cell phone while driving. Drivers can still use their phones to alert emergency responders and to make phone calls, use a GPS, and listen to music, if they are using hands-free technology.




